

Extract from the L2P Murraylands Learner Driver Support Program Introduction Booklet

L2P Participants

Eligible participants

This program is for young people (aged 16+ years) and others who have their learner's permit but are facing genuine barriers in getting their licence. It may be that the young person doesn't have access to a car or has no one who can act in the role of a supervising driver on an ongoing basis.

The following points are mandatory.

To be eligible for the L2P program participants must meet the following program criteria:

- Aged 16+ years – primarily for youth but older Murraylands residence may apply
- Hold a current Learners South Australian Drivers Permit – Mandatory
- Have limited or no access to a road worthy vehicle or suitable supervising driver - Mandatory
- Have completed a minimum of 3 professional driving lessons and be declared competent to safely operate a vehicle under volunteer supervision - Mandatory
- Completed a competency report at the end of the 3rd lesson from a Motor Driving Instructor - Mandatory
- Contribute to each driving session with a volunteer mentor with \$12 per session paid before commencing the session, or by agreement with the L2P Coordinator, to help cover costs i.e., fuel, car maintenance and registration etc.
- Each participant to attend a safety forum/meeting before program commencement:
Documents to be signed and returned before any pairing with a Mentor can be undertaken.
- Attend a further authorised professional driving lesson after 35 hours of L2P program participation.

Competency Statement

This statement can only be made and signed by a South Australian Registered Motor Driving Instructor, an MDI.
