

DRIVING SCHOOL ASSESSMENT FORM

L2P Murraylands is a Learner Driver Mentor Program (LDMP), approved by the SA Government and its applicable departments. L2P Murraylands engages volunteers (experienced drivers) from the community to assist disadvantaged learner drivers to complete the mandatory 75 hours of road driving experience required under the Graduated Learner Driver Scheme. L2P Murraylands is a not-for-profit organisation operating under the auspices of Energy Education Australia Inc. (ABN: 89 122 169 635)

Before L2P Murraylands accepts a disadvantaged learner driver into its program, we require that each learner drivers has a minimum of 1 lesson from an approved driver training school. To provide a safe environment for our volunteer driver mentors, it is expected that some learner drivers may require more (perhaps many more) than a single lesson. Issues of safety are very important for us – SafeWork SA lists our car as a **WORKPLACE**.

The following checklist is for your driving school to confirm a learner driver is ready to be supported by our program. L2P requires the learner driver be assessed against the following skills prior to full acceptance into the program. Please ensure that the learner driver reaches a satisfactory standard prior to signing off. This will ensure an adequate level of safety for our volunteers. L2P Murraylands car is a 1.6L 6sp automatic.

Element or Skill	Learner Driver's performance criteria – tick when satisfactory performance is reached	
Posture	Is able to adjust seating position, fit a seat belt, and adjust mirrors	
Cockpit drill	Is able to locate and operate basic vehicle controls (accelerator; brake; gear selector; indicators lights, and horn).	
Start engine	Applies the foot brake, selects 'park' or 'neutral' gear, then smoothly starts motor	
Move away	Selects 'drive' gear, is comfortably able to move the vehicle away. Completes a blind spot check	
Stopping	Applies brakes smoothly, and is able to use the correct pressure to stop at required place	
Steering	Is able to place a car in the correct or desired position (e.g. road lane, parking slot, etc.)	
Road law	Demonstrates a good understanding of 'give way' rules (e.g. at give way signs; stop signs; T- junctions; at roundabouts, when merging) and centre road markings	
Observant	Demonstrates an awareness of other vehicles (360 degrees). Sees road signs, road markings, and other road users (e.g. bicycles, pedestrians, etc.). Makes good use of mirrors	
Intersections	Will give way when necessary. Enters an intersection when it is safe to do so	
Lanes and line marking	Stays within a lane; obeys road markings; selects correct lane; changes lanes safely	
Hazard recognition	Reacts appropriately to potential hazards	
Speed	Adopts a safe road speed. Drives according to the road conditions. Observes speed limits	
Signalling	Signals when necessary	
Roundabouts	Gives way when necessary	
Manoeuvring	Able to maintain car control in a confined area. Judges distance from objects accurately
